Chosen 300 Ministries, Inc. Receives Matching Donation from Ambler Savings Bank

The matching gift helped Chosen 300 raise an additional \$8,000. "Through our email fundraising campaign to our network of churches, volunteers and supports we were able to raise all the money and more for the matching donation," commented Brian Jenkins, Executive Director at Chosen 300.
